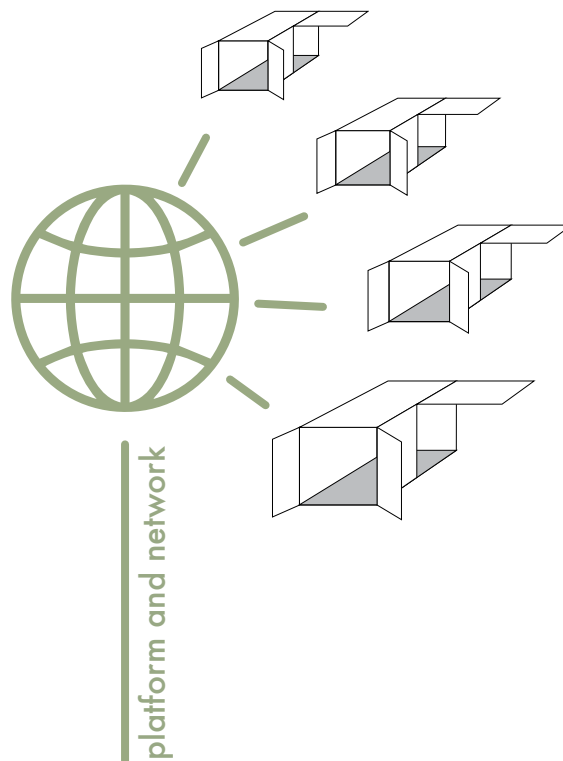

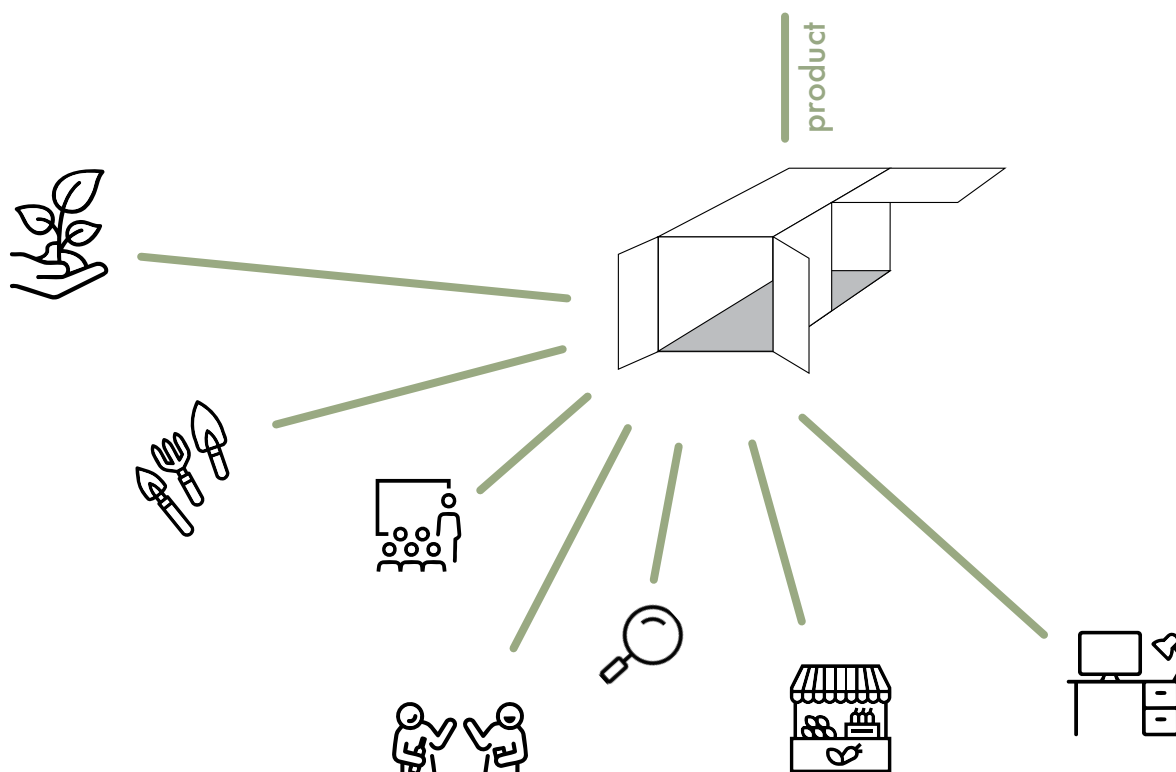

rewild farming.

..is a collective organization founded by benjamin onno dikmans and bram de vos that aims to empower people to contribute to their food systems and restore (eco)systems. our core philosophy is to diversify the agricultural sector and facilitate easier access to productive ecology through creating awareness and agency. in the next years we aim to create and connect more land-based projects, becoming a transnational network for regenerative practices.

since february 2025, we have been piloting a nature-cultural space in eindhoven, where city residents can gain insight into eco-productive systems and contribute to their environment through direct action and free activities.





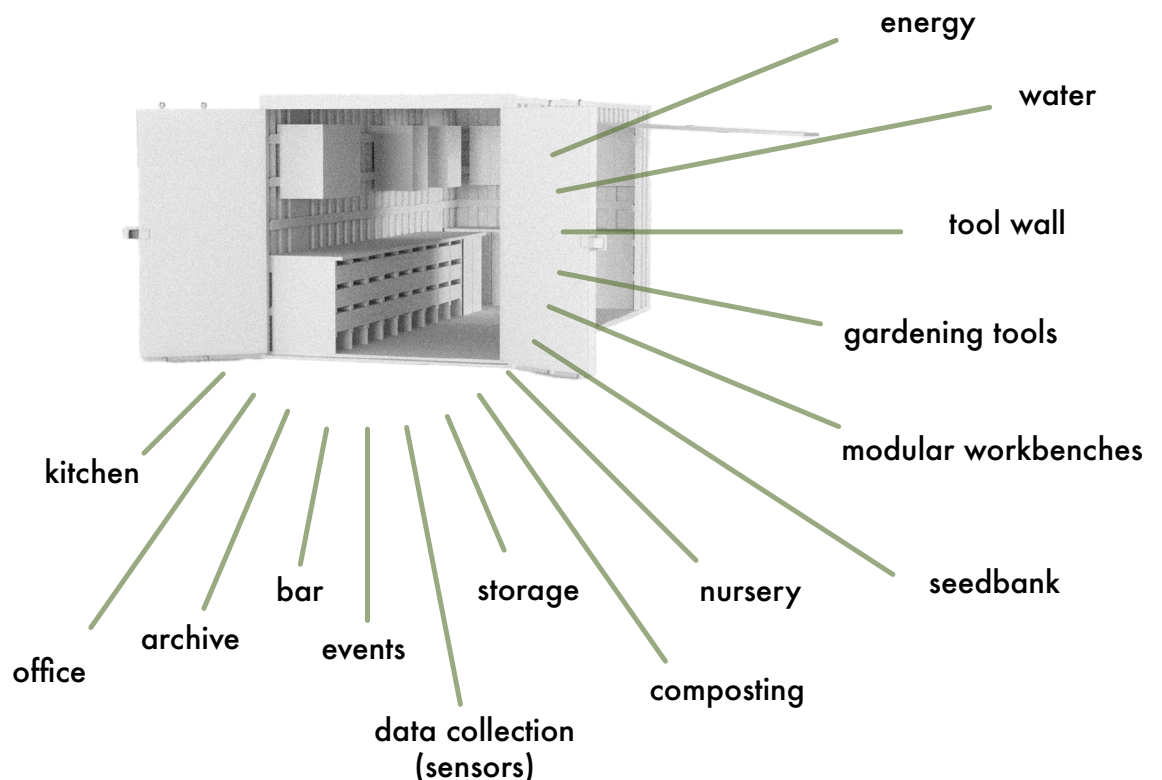

the starter kit.

..is a semi-mobile workspace for community-driven (eco)system restoration, making regenerative agriculture accessible to a wide audience. the product provides infrastructure adaptable to various locations and contexts, through a modular interior which includes a kitchen, electricity, water system, workbenches, storage, tool walls and an expandable scaffolding system — all completely demountable and transferable to other buildings.

the starter kit serves as a practical tool for the first years on location, by eliminating infrastructural barriers and facilitating immediate collective action.

pilot project

our pilot project at fuutlaan is the first real-world application of the starter kit, squatting parts of an abandoned industrial area and transforming it into a thriving eco-productive landscape. since february 2025, we have been actively cultivating both the physical space and a community of engaged participants who are learning about regenerative practices with each other.

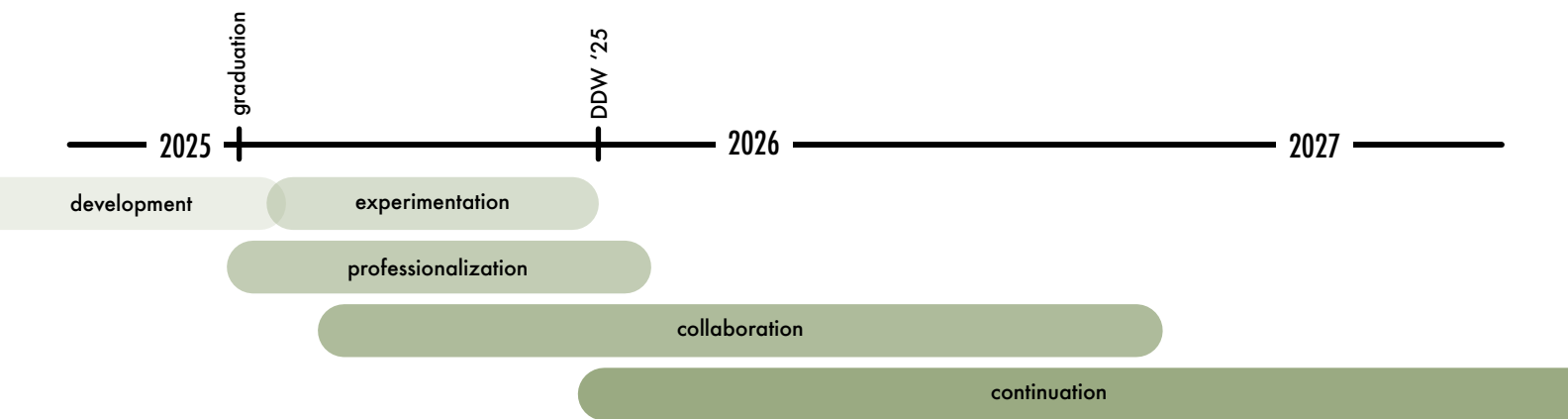
this space as living laboratory shows how urban spaces can be temporarily repurposed to create agency through activism. our initiative demonstrates how bottom-up urban development can effectively bridge institutional planning with grassroots action. with the formal development plans for the site not taking effect until 2030, this pilot project has already started engaging local residents, creatives, a garden center (tuincentrum soontiens), and various other institutions in creating a vibrant space that will shape the future of this area.

furthermore, the experimentation with our prototype provides valuable feedback on both technical aspects of the starter kit and social dynamics of community-led ecological transformation. the insights continuously refine our approach to facilitating agency within ecosystems and inform our strategy for future deployments in eindhoven and beyond.





our next steps are on three locations and in the digital realm.

*we are currently developing three starter kits (version 1-3), working with two locations and are running a digital prototype development, all with the help of amazing partners, and **WE ARE LOOKING FOR PARTNERS, specifically ones with location!***

whats next

in eindhoven we are experimenting within the urban fabric, revolutionizing urban development through serious but activist guerilla gardening. with our first year we have been focused on building collectivity and are now looking to professionalize with an agreement that will contractually put us into the team co-developing the future of the neighborhood park coming in 2030. with season 2 we are planning to scale up our eco-productive area from 100m2 to 1000m2 and involve more people in the food production.

we are looking to place the second starter kit in a sub-urban or rural area near madrid, barcelona, rome or brussels. in the beginning of 2026, we would like to start another site based project, connected to an institution or organization with a research approach to ecosystem restoration. from creatives to institutional and non-governmental...

we are developing a starter kit for the culture community center in kasungu, malawi for and with the NGO, shorten the distance. we're kickstarting this collaboration with a crowdfunding during DDW '25 and hope for collective support which will enable a first trans-continental collaboration. with this project we aim to extend our work into humanitarian and nature-catastrophic response through co-designing valuable concepts and approaches to rebuilding ecosystems. this work will be explorative and open ended with the approach of collaborating with multiple organizations that have many years of experience in the field.

under the guidance of citric labs, in collaboration with FAB LAB BCN and students from TU/e, we are developing an online service to facilitate knowledge exchange across diverse regenerative agricultural projects. we aim to create a digital tool that helps users track and share environmental impact data while using intelligent systems to combine and analyze data with experiential knowledge. this will create a growing knowledge base on ecosystem regeneration; a platform that connects various projects, enabling collaborative research and mutual support while amplifying our collective efforts and agency.

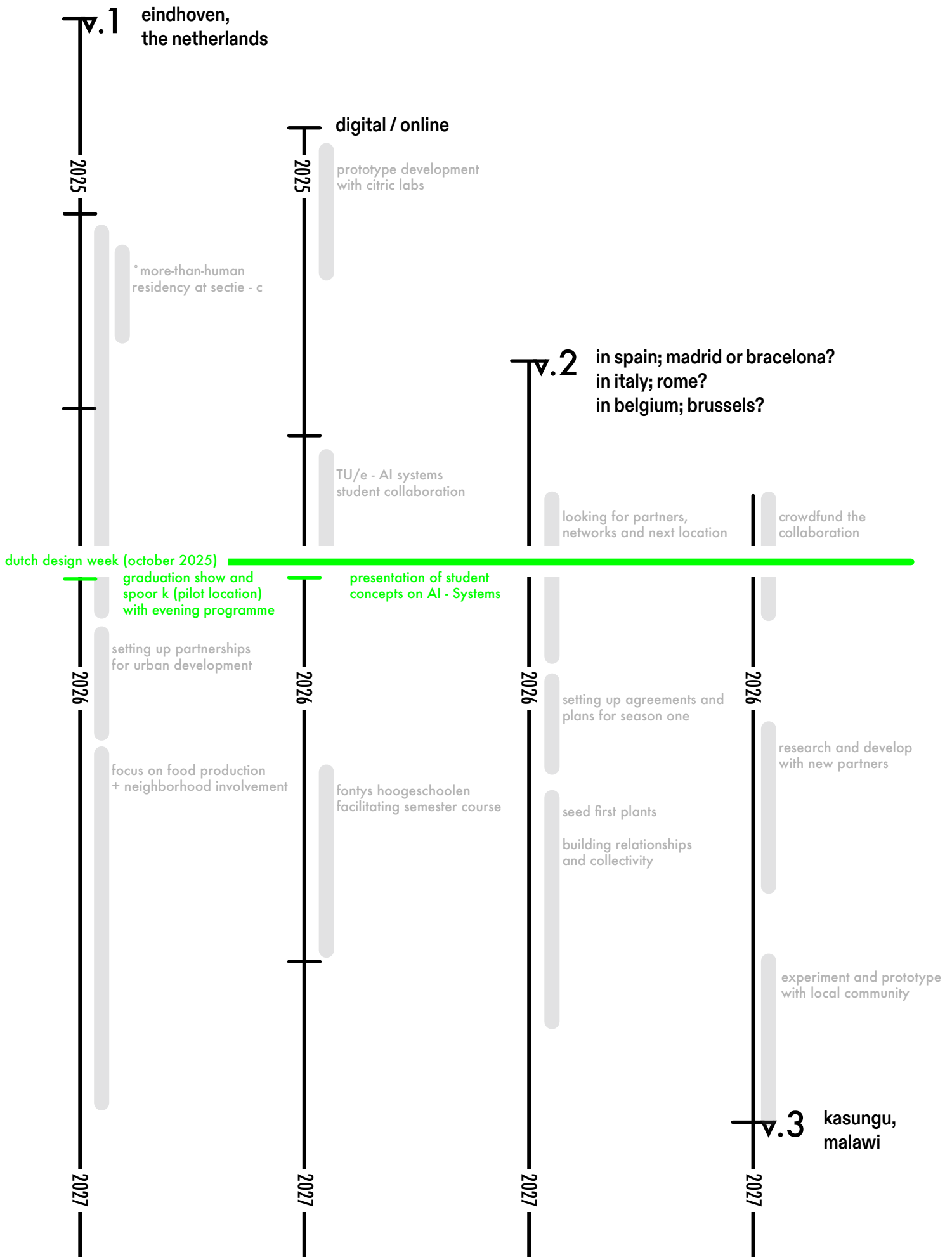
